#### Hi everyone,

We have completed all the letters with dual sounds. For those letters, it is not a big issue even if you happen to use the wrong sound. This week we will talk about the letters with very similar sounds but one has to be precise, to convey the correct meaning.

Let's review what we have covered so far.

#### An overview of the three letters for this week.

Previously, we were talking about letters, each of which had dual sounds. For those letters, it is not a big issue if you are careless about the actual sound. It is left to your convenience and above all, it will not convey a wrong meaning even if you happen to pronounce with the wrong sound.

This week it is exactly the reverse. There are three letters, each with a small variation in sound. They should be pronounced exactly as they are supposed to be. They might convey a completely different meaning, if you go wrong in the pronunciation.

Let me try to clarify those subtle differences in sound and help you get it correctly. With a little bit of effort, it is not at all difficult to learn it. Let us master it and feel proud about it.

Let's start with the easy one first.

"••" and its variations do not pose much of a challenge. They are easy to pronounce and usually no one makes any mistake. I have provided an audio guide also. Click on the speaker icon.

Is the pronunciation guide in the bottom row easy to follow?


You may have a look at the Table in the previous page explaining the tongue position, if you have any doubt.

Type all the above combinations, while pronouncing each letter loudly, and get used to both the sound and the letter.

Alternatively, you can use the Comments section of the YouTube.

Remember, if you are a desktop user, you should have Azhagi running and you should press ALT 3 to type in Thamizh. If you are a phone user, you have to switch to Azhagi (ஒலி பெயர்ப்பு) after LONG PRESS on Space Bar. There is also a shortcut. You can just touch the GLOBE icon to the left of the SPACE BAR.



When you touch the GLOBE icon

the Azhagi icon would appear. That means you are ready to type in Thamizh. The Space Bar caption also changes to "அழக".



What differentiates "**ต่า**" from **"ல்**" is the way the tongue behaves. When you say "**la**" it is just the tip of the tongue that touches the back part of the upper teeth. But when you say "**ต่า**", the tongue folds back.

Before we go on to all the variations of 617, let us get a little familiar with a few examples.

To denote the heavy sound of "61" we use the Upper case "L"

I suppose those examples and the audio guide (click on the speaker icon) would help you to pronounce these combinations, correctly.

Type all the above combinations, while pronouncing each letter loudly, and get used to both the sound and the letter.



ழ் is represented by zh. That is why தமிழ் is written as Thamizh.

To my knowledge, Thamizh is the only language in the World which has this sound. It is very difficult to explain the sound of this letter. Hope you are able to get a good idea when you click the speaker icons and hear the sound.

Regional accents are not so precise. They vary considerably. Over the years, people have slowly got used to the regional accents which deviate from the exact sound.

Let's watch a famous comedy clip to observe how the words வாழப்பழம் (vAzhappazham) and பழம் (pazham) are pronounced. Most of the characters, would be saying பளம் (paLam), which is acceptable as a regional accent, but not in a public Forum.

Having heard the different pronunciations of "\pu", I hope you are able to appreciate how the regional accent differs from the correct sound. Let's practice the various combinations with the correct sound. Click on the speaker icon.

Type all the combinations. As usual, practice pronouncing each letter loudly, and get used to both the sound and the letter. It is a wonderful flexibility exercise for your Tongue.

Instead of "zh", you can also type "z". Azhagi gives that facility. Type this sequence and see.

To reduce the typing effort, while typing in Thamizh, you can use just "z". But when we type Thanglish, let us stick to using "zh". "**Thamiz**" looks odd. "**Thamizh**" is better.

### **Example Word Collection**

Generally, every time we learnt a letter, we looked at example words pertaining to the usage of that particular letter. This time, we look at the words pertaining to all the three letters side by side.

Although the meanings of the words are given, you need not bother to learn / remember them. For the moment, it is enough if you understand that words look similar, with just one letter difference but can have entirely different meaning.

When you click on the speaker icon, you will hear me reading out all the words in this page. You track the words, as I keep reading. After I finish, you can read from the beginning.

I have given only a few samples here. A bigger list is given in the <u>Appendix</u>. Please do make it a point to go through all those words also.

Don't you see that minor differences in sound result in major differences in meaning?

#### Can you really be careless with your pronunciation?

Are you able to clearly say the words with their distinctly different sounds?

Just as saying "பளம்" instead "பழம்" is wrong, to say சுழுக்கு when one is supposed to say சுளுக்கு is also wrong.

A muscle catch (sprain), is called சுளுக்கு (suLukku). சுழுக்கு ("suzhukku" - has no meaning. One should always learn the correct pronunciation, whenever one learns a new word. We do this religiously when we learn English; let's follow the same practice while learning Thamizh also.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Many words have multiple meanings depending on the context; e.g. this word വേണ്. I am not giving all its meanings. Our objective is just to appreciate the similarity and the difference between the words.


## Are you ready for this challenge?

It is time for the "Read, Record, Play, Transcribe" challenge. We have three letters and they have three distinct pronunciations. You have to master the correct pronunciation and you have to evaluate yourself, your mastery over it.

Some people had some issues with making voice recordings. Here are some tips on that.

PC users: Windows has a built-in "Voice Recorder".

Android users: If you do not have any pre-installed apps, you may install this one from the Google Play Store. I have been using the free version for quite some time and I am happy with it.



iPhone users should already have something built-in. Even for Desktop users, it is convenient to use the Phone for recording.

The list of words is in the next page. You have already practiced reading them, earlier. To make it challenging, I have jumbled them up.

Start the voice recording, read one column of words at a time from the list and stop the recording. Take special care to clearly bring out the " $\omega$ ", " $\alpha$ ", and " $\omega$ " sounds so that when you listen to it, you should have no confusion at all.

Now play the recording, listen to the words and type them.

After you are done, compare your typed word with the original.

Did you get all your ல, ள and ழ correctly?

If yes, read the next column and repeat. Don't give up until you have got all the words correctly.

If No, observe where you are going wrong. Find out your weak point and work on it until you get it right.

This is a simple and effective way of perfecting your pronunciation. You are your best Critic and Judge. If you cannot understand your own pronunciation, obviously you can't expect others to understand you, right?

Do not ignore these challenges. Please take them seriously and do it sincerely.
